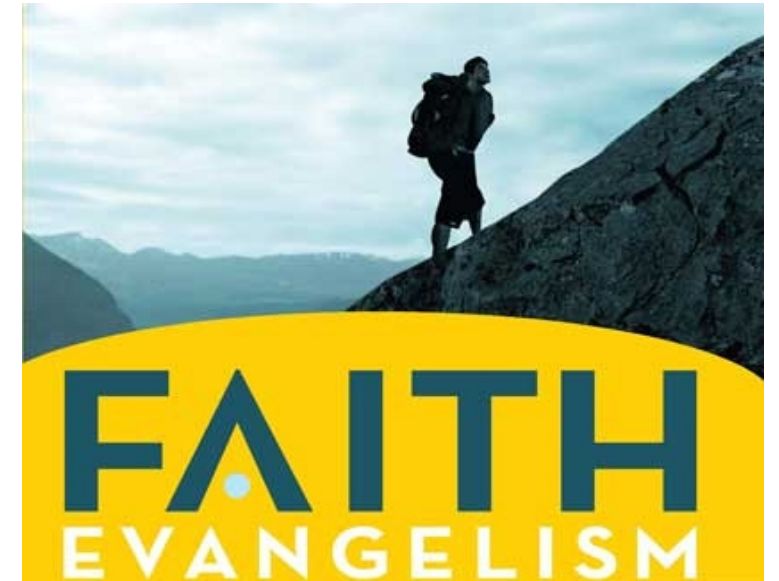

I leave our "stewardship series" after this Sunday with a concern for you getting the point.

Tony Evans tells a story of a young man named Danny Simpson. At the age of 24, he robbed a bank in Ottawa, Canada, at gun point. He robbed the bank of \$6,000. Shortly after, he was captured. The real tragedy of this true story is that the weapon he used to rob the bank was a 1918 45-caliber semi-automatic Colt worth \$100,000. Danny Simpson robbed a bank for \$6,000 with a weapon worth \$100,000. Danny's problem was that he did not know what he had in his hand. If had known, he probably wouldn't have chosen to be a thief. What he had in his possession would have given him so much more.

If Christians only knew what we have in our hand, we wouldn't have to rob God of His tithes or offerings. We'd realize that He could give us so much more. If we have God in our hands, we don't have a need of being thieves.

The deficits in the budget and in the missions outreach are a symptom of a sin sickness. I want to open your heart towards obedience for Iron City Baptist Church's future and for your future.

Jean & I take this personal because our God takes it personal. He is our "Promise Giver". He has been and will be the "Defender" of His faithful. I want us all to get the point and receive His healing for a healthy life and future.
